support distance learning students' mental wellbeing



Barriers

- DSA needs assessments can be very stressful for students, especially with mental health issues
- DSA support can be critical for student success
- There is a lack of training for needs assessors on assessing distance learners' support needs

Solutions

Professional development for DSA needs assessors focusing on how assessors can:

- support distance learners' wellbeing in needs assessments
- make recommendations for support to facilitate mental health in distance learning.

Approach

- A badged open course on OpenLearn
- A collaborative approach, with DSA assessors, disability experts, OU tutors and students on the authoring team

Next steps

- Promotion of the course in relevant circles
- Course due to launch on OpenLearn in Autumn 2020
